The Most Holy Trinity

Ex 34:4-6, 8-9 2 Cor 13:11-13 John 3:16-18

This week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, but what does it mean to believe in a Triune God?

The Trinity is probably one of the most difficult concepts to get our heads around. It's impossible to have a full understanding of the Trinity, and there will always be an element of mystery surrounding it. As humans, we are limited in our capacity to understand the true nature of God, but there are some things we can glean.

The difficulty comes in understanding that God is three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and yet at the same time, God is one. We don't profess a belief in three separate gods, so how do we make sense of God existing as three persons?

A helpful way to think about it is in terms of love. There are three components to love:

The person loving.

The person receiving the love.

The love shared between the two.

If we are to say that God is love, then we should expect to find these components within the life of God. If God was just the Father alone, then God in His essence would have nobody to love. He would have only himself to love, but that's not really love, because love requires an outpouring of oneself for the other.



This is partly why we say that within the life of God, there exists the three persons, and this is for the sake of love. The Father and Son love each other, and the Holy Spirit is the love shared between the two.

"God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life." – John 3, 16.

God's love, however, doesn't stop with the three persons. We read today in the Gospel that God loved the world so much, that he gave his only Son. With the inner life of God being love, God does something truly amazing. He shares this inner life of love with us. Love is not reserved for the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Rather, the eternal wellspring of God's love is offered to each of us as a gift. Thanks be to God.

Feast Day: 5 JuneBoniface, known as the apostle of the Germans,

was an English Benedictine

his life to the conversion of the Germanic tribes. Two characteristics stand out: his Christian orthodoxy and his fidelity to the pope of Rome. How absolutely necessary this orthodoxy and fidelity were is borne out by the conditions Boniface found on his first missionary journey in 719 at the request of Pope Gregory II. What Christianity he did find had either lapsed into paganism or was mixed with error. The clergy were mainly responsible for these latter conditions since they were in many instances uneducated, lax and questionably obedient to their bishops. The Holy Father instructed him to reform the German Church. During a final mission to the Frisians, Boniface and 53 companions were massacred while he was preparing converts for

monk who gave up being elected abbot to devote

Rome. The second was the establishment of many houses of prayer which took the form of Benedictine monasteries. A great number of Anglo-Saxon monks and nuns followed him to the continent, where he introduced the Benedictine nuns to the active

principles. The first was to restore the obedience of

the clergy to their bishops in union with the pope of

confirmation. In order to restore the Germanic Church to its fidelity to Rome and to convert the pagans, Boniface had been guided by two
