Such was said to your ancestors; but I am speaking to you

Sir 15:15-20 1 Cor 2:6-10 Mt 5:17-37

COMMENTARY This Sunday, our readings invite us to consider God's laws and true wisdom. Our attitude may depend on whether we respond to God's law of love, or see it only as a legal imposition. In the First Reading, Ben Sirach underlines how God has given us loving guidelines, but it is entirely up to us as to how we respond. God has also given us the gift of free will. The Psalmist praises God's law: we will experience happiness as we seek God and follow in his ways. St Paul (Second Reading) points out that true wisdom comes from God. Only the Spirit of God can reach the depths of all things. St Matthew, in the Gospel, describes the relationship between the Law of Moses and the more radical vision of Jesus. Jesus has not come to abolish the Law but to complete it. During this week, as we strive, with God's grace, to follow his law, may we be inspired by the example of so many who surround us.

GOSPEL Matthew 5: 17-37 (shorter form) Jesus said to his disciples, 'I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. 'You have heard that it was said to those of old, "You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgement." But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgement. 'You have heard that it was said, "You shall not commit adultery." But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart. 'Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, "You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform to the Lord what you have sworn." But I say to you: Do not take an oath at all. Let what you say be simply "Yes" or "No"; anything more than this comes from evil.'

REFLECTION As I prepare to pray, I take the time to come into the Lord's presence. I slow my breath, conscious of breathing in God's goodness and love. I put aside other concerns and rest in his presence. When I am ready, I read the text a couple of times. I may like to place myself in the crowd, listening as Jesus teaches. What strikes me in his words or attitude?

Maybe I am sometimes like the scribes or Pharisees, practising my religion externally. How can I deepen my observance? Or how has Jesus's teaching changed my motivations? Jesus gives examples from the Law of Moses and takes each one to another level. In what way can I apply this to my life, to my experience?

Jesus's law is a Law of Love. He is not adding to my burden. I can turn to him and speak from my heart. Perhaps I express my need of his Spirit to help me follow his way. I end my prayer with gratitude for those he has sent me to give me support and example.

across our globe. Manaini and her children
living in rural Fiji. With the support from
Caritas Australia's partner, FRIEND, she learnt
food processing and gardening skills,
improving nutrition and creating new income
opportunities to support her children's educa-
tion. The project also brought solar lights to the
village. Before, nights were dark and unsafe.
Families used kerosene lamps if they could
afford the fuel. Now, Manaini's children can
play safely, and elderly people can walk safely
at night. We remember February 13th as the
day Prime Minister Rudd made the apology for
the Stolen Generations, locally our Hills Yarning
group has created a learning guide for Marella
Mission which is now Bernie Mullane Sports
Centre. We are sorry.

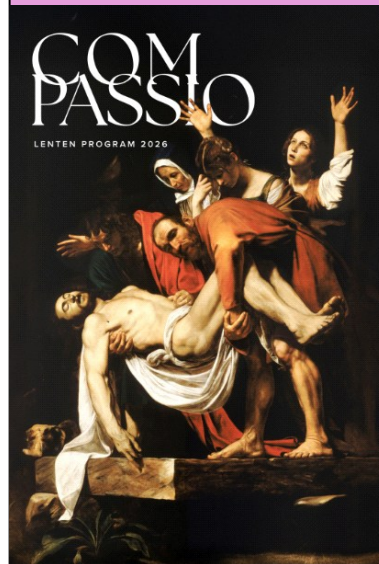
