GOSPEL Matthew 10: 37-42

Jesus instructed the Twelve as follows: 'Anyone who prefers father or mother to me is not worthy of me.

Anyone who prefers son or daughter to me is not worthy of me. Anyone who does not take their cross and follow in my footsteps is not

worthy of me. Anyone who finds their life will lose it; anyone who loses their life for my sake will find it.

Anyone who welcomes you
welcomes me; and those who

welcome me welcome the one who sent me.

Anyone who welcomes a prophet will have a prophet's reward; and anyone who welcomes a holy man will have a holy man's reward. If anyone gives so much as a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because they are a disciple, then I tell you solemnly, they will most certainly not lose their reward.'

COMMENTARY This Sunday's readings reveal the demands and choices Jesus's disciples have to make as they share in his new life and carry on his mission. The Gospel continues Jesus' teaching on the mission of his disciples. Here we see the cost – but also the generous rewards. In addition, those who welcome the missionary also welcome Jesus himself. The story in the First Reading illustrates this teaching. God rewards the childless couple who welcome the prophet Elisha into their home with the gift of a child. The Psalm expresses the joy of the disciple whose faith is not in rules, but in the loving presence of their Lord and leader, and who walks in his light. St Paul in his letter to the Romans (Second Reading) reminds us that through our baptism we now live a 'new life' in the Risen Christ. It is through life in Christ Jesus that disciples can live the demands of mission.

This week, we pray for the grace to follow Christ even more closely, and welcome him in others.

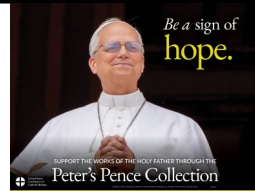
